Friday, May 24, Last day of the Preschool Session & Sing-a-long

All families are invited to join us for a school wide sing-a-long beginning at 11:15am.
Children going home at noon will be dismissed from the classrooms.

We are back outside! Please apply sunscreen to your child before coming to school. Shoes need to be safe for climbing on the playground equipment. Shoes that slip off easily are not ok. Please label all jackets, hats, and sweaters. Children who stay for both sessions should have a sunscreen stick at school with a signed consent form.

Arrival & Dismissal Reminder:

To enter the building: On the keypad to the right of the front door, push your child's classroom button. **Smiley-4, Heart-6, Bear- 5, Ocean-7A, Jungle-8.** When prompted please announce your child's name and classroom in order to gain access into the building. If no one answers, wait until ringing stops and try another room.

Arrival: Children must be taken to their classrooms by an adult. Please wait until the scheduled time to enter the room.

Dismissal: Parents and other authorized adults must come into the classroom at dismissal time. For the security and safety of the children, the adults must initial a sign-out sheet before leaving with a child. Only persons listed on the emergency card will be permitted to leave with that child unless the parent provides written permission. Verbal permission is acceptable in emergency situations. The staff will ask for photo identification.
