Snow Policy Reminders:

Families will be notified about any weather-related MDOW closings or delays via email, brightwheel messaging, and Facebook posts. Please be alert to local media weather-related announcements when bad weather is in the forecast.

MDOW **generally** follows what Baltimore County Public Schools decide. If schools are opening 1 or 2 hours late, MDOW would open at 10:00 am with no beforecare. If schools are closed, MDOW is closed. If schools close early, MDOW Discovery is cancelled and you should pick up your child as soon as you are able.

Sickness policy

Please remember that children sick with fever, diarrhea or vomiting must remain home for at least 24 hours after they are fever-free, diarrhea-free or vomit-free without the use of symptom-relieving medication.
