All classrooms have afternoon session spots available...

Morning Before Care and Afternoon Discovery Clubs – No registration is needed to attend.

• On as as-needed basis each day, please know that students are welcome as early as 7:30 am before their 9:00 classroom opening.

• After 3:30 class dismissal each day, attending Discovery Clubs up until 5:30 pm is available. Please let your child's teacher know at drop-off, or call the office that day before 3:30. A great option when something unexpected comes up in your afternoon schedule.

Students' personal items at MDOW

• **Labeled items**: Please be sure that everything your child brings to school--including all removable outer garments--remains clearly labeled. At the end of the year, we have many unlabeled, unclaimed jackets, sweaters, sweatshirts, shoes, hats and bedding.

• Sunscreen/Diaper creams: Please apply sunscreen to your child before they come to school. Full-day children should have sunscreen that can remain at school. Stick sunscreen is preferred for ease of application. All labeled sunscreens or diaper creams must be in a labeled plastic zip-loc bag accompanied by a completed, signed Topical Basic Care Product Authorization Form, available from your classroom or the office.

Sickness policy

Please remember that children sick with fever, diarrhea or vomiting must remain home for at least 24 hours after they are fever-free, diarrhea-free or vomit-free without symptom-relieving medication.
